Policy on Obstructions of Public Rights of Way

Adopted February 10, 2003

The purpose of the following regulations are to prescribe requirements and controls to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the public and to minimize inconvenience to the public as a result of creating an obstruction of the Public Right of Way.

1. Temporary obstructions of any Village street, alley, parkway or sidewalk shall require a permit in accordance with Section 5-2-6 of the River Forest Municipal Code.
2. Roll-off receptacles (dumpsters) may be placed on Public Right of Way provided that the receptacle:
 - Is not placed with 15 feet of a fire hydrant;
 - Is not placed within 25 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;
 - Is not placed within 10 feet of a private driveway on either side of the street. This requirement may be waived for the subject property's driveway only if it is otherwise impossible to meet the 10-foot requirement.
 - Is located in a legal parking area if placed on a street;
 - Is protected by a barricade with working flashing lights at each street-side corner;
 - Is clearly marked with the name and 24-hour contact phone number of the owner of the receptacle;
 - Is free of graffiti as defined in Section 8-6-20 of the River Forest Municipal Code;
 - Is owned and placed by a company that is licensed and bonded as a Waste disposal firm in accordance with Sections 3-3-1, 3-3-2 and 3-3-3 of the River Forest Municipal Code.
 - The Village reserves the right to deny the renewal of an existing permit beyond 120 days to minimize public inconvenience.
3. It shall be the responsibility of the permit holder/property owner to remove the accumulation of snow and/or leaves during and after the placement of the dumpster.
