APPLICANT INFORMATION

The purpose of the following information is to provide you with sufficient knowledge about the River Forest Fire Department, so that you can make a decision as to whether or not you wish to test competitively for a position on the firefighter/paramedic applicant eligibility list. The testing is demanding and will take a period of time to complete. There currently is one firefighter/paramedic position open at this time. This test is being conducted to maintain an eligibility roster as required by law.

COMMUNITY INFORMATION

The Village of River Forest was incorporated in 1880. According to the 2000 census, the population of the community is 11,635, with 4,092 housing units. The median family income in 2000 was \$122,155. The village consists mainly of residential single-family homes, with some multi-family housing. There are commercial areas, primarily bordering North Avenue, Madison Street and the Lake Street area. The village has recently developed new commercial areas in the community by the use of Tax Increment Financing districts.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

The River Forest Fire Department employs 15 full-time firefighter/paramedics, 5 Lieutenants, 1 Deputy Chief and the Fire Chief.

TRAINING INFORMATION

Personnel that are appointed to the department will be required to attend 8 to 10 weeks of basic training at one of the authorized training academies and pass a Firefighter II examination authorized through the Office of the State Fire Marshal.

Each recruit must:

1. Successfully complete the training program to become certified as a Firefighter II, Haz Mat Awareness.
2. Pass the required examination administered at the Academy to be certified in the above areas in the State of Illinois.
3. After graduation from the academy, the employee will be assigned to a three-week orientation program working with all three shifts to acclimate the employee to the department and his or her role as a firefighter/paramedic for the Village of River Forest.
4. Failure to accomplish these goals will result in dismissal of the recruit from the River Forest Fire Department.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

The River Forest Fire Department works on a 24-hour on-duty and 48 hours off duty shift basis. Recruits are rotated annually so they will have the opportunity to work on all three shifts. Shift adjustments are made as necessary to maintain appropriate staffing. Currently, the shift hours are:

7:45 AM - 7:45 AM

At the discretion of the Fire Chief, personnel can be assigned to shift schedules to meet the demand of the department.

SALARY

The salary schedule is a five-year matrix.
Paramedic Pay = 6.1% of top FF Salary

EDUCATIONAL INCENTIVE

The River Forest Fire Department has an annual incentive pay program for those officers who have obtained college credits as follows:

KELLY DAYS & PERSONAL DAY

All shift personnel are given eleven (11) Kelly Days off per year to reduce the workweek hours. These days are scheduled by the Fire Chief in accordance with past practice. Each shift personnel are given one Personal Day off per year.

Firefighters receive 8 hours Holiday Pay for 12 holidays, based upon a 40 hr. week salary. Firefighters work holidays unless it is a regularly scheduled day off. Holiday payments are made twice each year.

SICK LEAVE POLICY

Employees earn twelve hours of sick leave per month (6 days per year) and can accrue up to 2880 hours (120, 24 hours shifts days) of sick time over the period of employment.

UNIFORM ALLOWANCE

All personnel receive all their uniforms and turnout gear from the Fire Department. Clothing is replaced on a Quartermaster Plan.

INSURANCE PROGRAM

Hospitalization is provided with a shared cost between employee and employer. The employee pays 15% of the respective cost of his/her chosen plan. Dental care is provided for the employee only. Family coverage can be provided through group policy at full cost to employee. Life insurance is provided at no cost, in the amount of \$50,000.

PENSION PLAN

A separate application must be made to the River Forest Firefighters Pension Board for acceptance into the Down State Firemen's Pension Plan. Personnel qualify for pension after 20 years of service and after 50 years of age. The basic fire pension is 50% of the salary attached to their rank on their last paycheck. Pensions escalate to 75% of salary based on length of service.

FIREFIGHTER'S FACT SHEET - 2010

The position of Firefighter/Paramedic with the River Forest Fire Department will provide you with a rewarding and challenging career. Some of the items you need to know are these:

The River Forest Fire Department operates out of one (1) station. The Department has the following personnel: a Fire Chief, one (1) Deputy Chief, five (5) Lieutenants and fifteen (15) Firefighters.

Each shift is assigned one (1) Lieutenant, five (5) Firefighters.

We have two (2) Engines (one front line, one reserve) one (1) Aerial Ladder Truck and two (2) Ambulances (one front line, one reserve.)

Personnel are assigned as follows: With a FULL shift, One (1) Lieutenant and two (2) Firefighters are assigned to an engine and (2) Firefighters are assigned to the Aerial Ladder Truck. (2) Firefighter/Paramedics are assigned to the ambulance. FF/PM's assigned to the ambulance "Jump" to the engine on fire calls.

The position of Firefighter/Paramedic involves knowledge in the physics and chemistry of fire and its relation to the nature of combustion and hazardous chemicals. The position also involves knowledge of fire prevention methods, fire hazards, fire suppression devices and equipment; knowledge in building construction methods, materials and blueprint reading; knowledge and skills in emergency medicine.

The position of Firefighter/Paramedic also requires you to learn and apply a variety of fire fighting duties, evolutions and methods, including the operation of advanced fire fighting apparatus within reasonable working test periods. You must demonstrate the ability to climb ladders and to work at considerable heights. You must also demonstrate the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with others, co-workers, Village employees and the general public.

You must have the ability to meet standards of physical conditioning, which assures that each Firefighter can safely perform the life saving responsibilities inherent in fire fighting work.

You must have a Paramedic License from the Illinois Department of Public Health and be certified to operate in the Loyola Medical Center EMS System.

Upon employment, you must take, pass and become certified as a Firefighter I & II through a program approved by the Illinois State Fire Marshal's Office Division of Education and Training.

As a condition of employment, you must maintain your Paramedic License with the Illinois Department of Public Health and your certification with the Emergency Medical System under which the Village of River Forest Fire Department operates.

During your first four (4) years of employment, you must become certified as a Firefighter III.

This Fact Sheet is intended merely to identify the kinds of tests and duties that may be required and assigned to Firefighters. It should not be interpreted as describing all of the duties whose performance may be required of a Firefighter or be used to limit the nature and extent of assignments a Firefighter may be given.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC

INITIAL STAGE

An applicant will be disqualified for further consideration if he/she does not return their application and requested documentation by the deadline or does not attend the scheduled orientation, tests, and examinations at the appointed times.

1. Applicants return completed Preliminary Application along with documentation (see the Instruction Sheet) to the River Forest Municipal Complex not later than 4:30 PM Friday, March 19, 2010.
2. Orientation for all Applicants: Thursday, March 25, 2010.
3. Written Examination Test for Applicants: Saturday, March 27, 2010.
4. Physical Agility Test for all Applicants who pass the Written Examination Test: Saturday, March 27, 2010.
5. **NOTE: THE WRITTEN EXAMINATION AND PHYSICAL AGILITY TEST ARE ON THE SAME DAY.**

SECOND STAGE

For those Applicants who successfully pass both the Physical Aptitude Test and Written Examination:

6. Prepare the in-depth application form (distributed after the Written Test) along with documentation (see Rules and Regulations included in this Packet). Submit this documentation at the Oral Interview.
7. Participate in an Oral Interview. Participants will be notified of the exact date and time of their interview after the Physical Aptitude test.

THIRD STAGE

The Initial Eligibility Register, listing the applicants who have passed the Written Examination, the Physical Aptitude Test and Oral Interview in order of their score, will be published and mailed to those applicants on the Register.

8. Those Applicants placed on the Initial Eligibility Register and have had Military Service, educational level, Fire Fighter and/or Paramedic points which qualifies them for Preference Points must submit a request in writing, along with proof thereof for application of such points within 10 days of the posted date of the Initial Eligibility Register.
9. Posting of the Final Eligibility Register reflecting Preference points for qualifying applicants. This register is effective for two years from the date of posting.

FINAL STAGE

As a vacancy for Fire Fighter/Paramedic occurs, the candidates will be selected from the Final Eligibility Register in rank order and the following will be conducted in the order listed:

- A Polygraph Evaluation.

If the Candidate passes the Polygraph Evaluation, then the following will be conducted:

- A thorough Background Investigation.
- A Criminal Background check
- A Credit Check
- The Candidate visits the Fire Department for familiarization purposes.
- Participate in a final Oral Interview with the Commission.

If the Candidate completes the Oral Interview satisfactorily, then the Commission will extend a Conditional Offer of Employment as a Probationary Firefighter/Paramedic and request the Candidate take the following examinations.

- An in-depth Psychological Examination.
- An in-depth Medical Examination including drug screening.

The Applicant must successfully pass all the above items and become a qualified Paramedic in the Loyola University Medical Center EMS Program, the program under which River Forest presently operates, to qualify for Probationary Appointment as Fire Fighter/Paramedic and to start work with the Department.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE BOARD OF RIVER FOREST FIRE AND POLICE COMMISSIONERS

Excerpts from the Rules and Regulations of the River Forest Fire and Police Commission regarding applicants for the position of Fire Fighter/Paramedic are listed below. Those persons submitting applications should carefully review these rules and regulations to insure they qualify for the position.

A copy of the Rules and Regulations in its entirety is available for review at the Municipal Complex, 400 North Park Avenue, River Forest, Illinois.

A false statement knowingly made by a person in an application for examination, connivance in any false statement made in any certificate which may accompany such application or complicity in any fraud touching the same, shall be regarded as good cause for exclusion from the examination

RESIDENCE

Applicants for examination must be citizens of the United States and/or an alien admitted for permanent residence or lawfully admitted for temporary residence and who produces evidence of intention to become a citizen of the United States.

APPLICATION BLANKS

Applications for position shall be filed upon blank forms furnished by the Commission, and applicants must comply with the requirements of said form in every respect. The application must be filed with the Board prior to taking an examination.

Every applicant must be of good moral character, of temperate habits, of sound health and must be physically able to perform the duties of the position applied for. The burden of establishing these facts rests upon the applicant.

DEFECTIVE APPLICATIONS

Defective applications shall be returned to the applicant for correction, provided the applicant is not otherwise disqualified for the position sought.

AGE REQUIREMENTS

Applicants shall be under 35 years of age unless exempt from such age limitation as provided in § 5/10-2.1-6 of the Fire and Police Commissioners Act. All applicants must, at a minimum, be at least 21 years of age at time application. Proof of birth date will be required at time of application.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE BOARD OF RIVER FOREST FIRE AND POLICE COMMISSIONERS - CONTINUED

DISQUALIFICATION

The Board may refuse to examine an applicant or, after examination, to certify him/her as eligible:

- a) Who is found lacking in any of the established preliminary requirements for the service for which he or she applies.
- b) Who is physically unable to perform the duties of the position to which he or she seeks appointment.
- c) Who is addicted to the use of intoxicating beverages or is found to have taken or used drugs and/or narcotics illegally.
- d) Who has been convicted of a felony or any misdemeanor involving moral turpitude, as specified in § 5/10-2.1-6 of the Fire and Police Commissioners Act.
- e) Who has been dismissed from any public service for good cause.
- f) Who has attempted to practice any deception or fraud in his or her application.
- g) Who may be found disqualified in personal qualifications or health
- h) Whose character and employment references are unsatisfactory.
- i) Who does not possess a high school education or its equivalent.
- j) Who has applied for a position of a Firefighter/Paramedic and is or has been classified by his or her Local Selective Service Draft Board as a conscientious objector.
- l) Who is applying for a position as a Fire Fighter/Paramedic and who is not licensed and certified as a paramedic by the Illinois Department of Public Health.

Any applicant, or eligible, deemed disqualified hereunder, shall be notified by the Board.

PHYSICAL AND MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS

Applicants for original appointment may be subject to a physical aptitude test and shall be required to submit to a thorough medical examination by a licensed physician appointed by the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners of the Village of River Forest.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY

All applicants shall execute and deliver to the Board a release of all liability as the result of taking a "Physical Aptitude Test" in favor the Village of River Forest on a form to be prescribed by the Board.

FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC PHYSICAL AGILITY EXAMINATION

Summary

The Firefighter Physical Agility Examination is designed to test an applicant's physical ability and stamina to perform the duties that are relevant to the position of Firefighter/Paramedic. The examination consists of five parts, including both timed and pass-fail events.

Scoring and Guidelines

1. The minimum score needed for passing is 15. This means that you need to achieve an average score of at least a 3 on each of the five parts of the examination. Moderate rest periods will be allowed between parts of the examination.
2. However, you will be expected to complete the test in order of admission. Anyone who is unable to complete the test within the time prescribed by the test administrator will be marked as a fail.
3. All parts of the test must be completed, regardless of score. However, if you will be unable to achieve a passing score of at least 15 by the time you reach your final event, you will not be allowed to go any further.
4. No one will be allowed to take part of the test more than once to change a score. If you dispute a score, contact the test administrator immediately. All scores entered at the conclusion of the test will be final.

Events

1. Ladder Hang.

The candidate must hang from a ladder that is propped against a building at a narrow angle. The candidate must hang inside the angle of the ladder facing the ladder, feet off the ground, with palms forward and arms forming a 90-degree angle. This is a timed event and candidates will be competing against pre-established time limits.

2. Half-Mile Run.

Candidates will be timed in running a half-mile around an oval track or other suitable area. Candidates will be competing against pre-established time limits.

3. Ladder Climb.

The candidate must climb to the top of an aerial ladder, which is set at a 60 to 70 degree angle from the ground and is extended 3/4 length. The candidate will begin the climb from the truck platform and must proceed to the furthest extension of the ladder and back down wearing the following protective gear: bunker coat, air tank and helmet. This is a pass-fail event and is not timed.

Scoring:

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4. Rescue Drag.

Candidates will drag an 80 pound weight to simulate a body along a 120 foot obstacle course which will include a 10 foot long tunnel approximately 40" high and 40" wide. Candidates will be required to wear the following protective gear: bunker coat and helmet. This is a timed event and candidates will be competing against pre-established time limits.

5. Building Maze.

Candidates will proceed through a building maze, consisting of chairs, desks, tables and other obstacles, by crawling on their hands and knees and following a length a rope from one end of a room to the other end. Candidates will wear full protective clothing and will have their facemasks taped over. They must follow the rope from one end of the course to the other end without letting go of the rope. This is a timed event and candidates will be competing against pre-established time limits.

VILLAGE OF RIVER FOREST

FACT SHEET

River Forest is a vibrant community of beautiful homes, dedicated to high cultural and educational ideals, and emphasizing service to its population. The affluence of its early settlers shaped the character of the community. They built large, lovely homes and donated land and money to build fine schools and churches. River Forest is known as the “Village of Churches and Schools”. This together with River Forest’s appealing wooded comforts and proximity to Chicago attracted other wealthy families to the Village.

River Forest has been a settled community for more than 15 decades; it is two and one half square miles in area and has a population of 11,635 residents. During the early years well-known architects practiced their art in the village. As a result, homes in River Forest reflect the many periods of home design. Superb examples are contained within an historic district, encompassing a quarter of the community’s residences and displaying an array of Italianate, Queen Ann, Medieval, and Classic Revival architectural designs. Prominent Prairie School designs by the pioneering architectural genius Frank Lloyd Wright are also present.

Most of River Forest’s dwellings were constructed before World War II, several sections of the community contain modern, four and five story condominiums and apartments offering luxury with the demand of single family home ownership. Homes range in price from \$185,000.00 to over \$4,000,000.00.

River Forest is a Village form of government with a Village President and six Trustees. A full time professional Village Administrator runs the day to day operations. There is a fully manned Police Department, full time Fire Department, and a full time Public Works Department.

The Village recently completed a new Municipal Complex that consolidates all Village services in one location. The New River Forest Town Center, containing shops and eateries has been very successful and there are plans for another shopping center at the opposite end of the Village.

River Forest is the home of Dominican University (formerly Rosary College) affiliated with the Roman Catholic Church and Concordia University with the Lutheran Missouri Synod Church.

Almost fully developed, the village strives for maintenance and improvement of its infrastructures, assuring future generations the same high standard and quality of life that is a tradition in River Forest.
